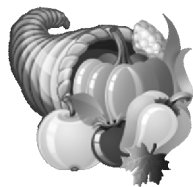

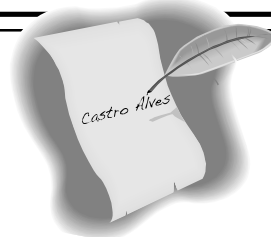

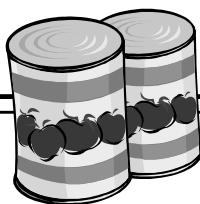

ENDING DATE: December 9, 2009

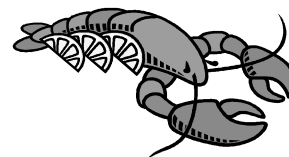

Once again we will be hosting a White Elephant gift exchange at our Christmas Celebration.

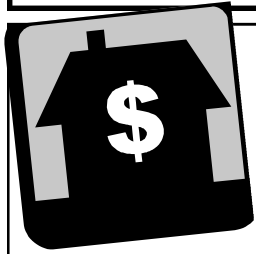

Time to get ready for winter

- Mobile Home tenants
 - Do you have an exterior mounted air conditioner? All exterior mounted units should have been taken down by November 1st. If braces for the unit are not permanently affixed to the home, they must be stored out of sight as well.
- RV tenants
 - All above ground piping must be protected from freezing with adequate heat tape and wrapped with insulation. Winterization should be completed no later than November 1st.

Free Weatherization service for low income seniors: On October 14th, we had an official application day here at the recreational hall with Patsy Benson from Kitsap County Community Services. It was a very successful day, with over a dozen applicants. We accomplished a lot.

It is still not too late to apply for grant money to improve your roof, heating system, water heater, attic insulation, water pipes, air ducts and much more. We have all the instructional paperwork here at the office. We encourage anyone interested to come down and pick up a set, gather a few papers of your own, and you will be ready to apply.

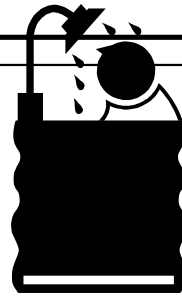

RECIPE OF THE MONTH: Awesome Sausage, Apple and Cranberry Stuffing

Prep Time: 15 minutes Total Time: 25 minutes Makes: 10

INGREDIENTS

1-1/2 cups cubed whole wheat bread
3-3/4 cups cubed white bread
1 pound ground turkey sausage
1 cup chopped onion
3/4 cup chopped celery
2-1/2 teaspoons dried sage
1-1/2 teaspoons dried rosemary
1/2 teaspoon dried thyme
1 Golden Delicious apple, cored and chopped
3/4 cup dried cranberries
1/3 cup minced fresh parsley
1 cooked turkey liver, finely chopped
3/4 cup turkey stock
4 tablespoons unsalted butter, melted



DIRECTIONS

1. **Preheat** oven to 350 degrees. Spread the white and whole wheat bread cubes in a single layer on a large baking sheet. Bake for 5 to 7 minutes in the preheated oven, or until evenly toasted. Transfer toasted bread cubes to a large bowl.
2. In a large skillet, cook the sausage and onions over a medium heat, stirring and breaking up the lumps until evenly browned. Add the celery, sage, rosemary, and thyme; cook, stirring, for 2 minutes to blend flavors.
3. Pour sausage mixture over bread in bowl. Mix in chopped apples, dried cranberries, parsley, and liver. Drizzle with turkey stock and melted butter, and mix lightly. Spoon into turkey to loosely fill.
