



RV'ers - Air Conditioning Maintenance

Here are some helpful tips to think of in reference to the cooling of your RV:

- Clean the filters on a regular basis when the air conditioner is being used throughout the year.
- Clean the condenser a couple times per year. In order to do this, blow compressed air through the coil from the inside out. If you use water to clean the condenser coil, remember to disconnect any power when cleaning
- Remember that a minimum of 15 Amp power is required to operate your RV furnace fan.
- Check the air intake/outtake on regular intervals to ensure efficient use.
- Inspect the vents for insect or bird nests or other debris or obstructions

A Reminder

If you are plugged into a 30 amp electrical outlet use caution when using your air conditioning and operating other high amperage appliances in your unit. You will overload your electrical pedestal and may cause damage to both your unit and/or the electrical pedestal servicing your electricity. **USE CAUTION AND COMMON SENSE!!!!**
